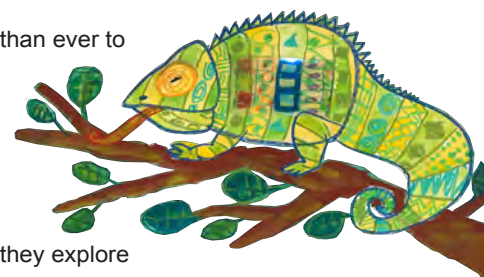


Ready for Creative Action!

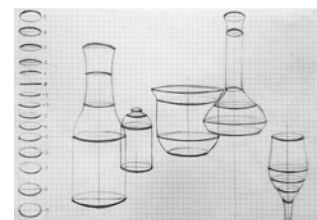
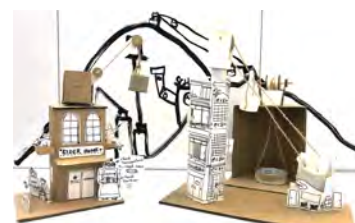
children innovating new habitats and modes of transportation as they design mobile houses, pulley systems and co-existence with animals in the cities...
